


## 5TH ANNUAL FUNDRAISING GOLF TOURNAMENT





**Running White Wolves Backgrounder** 

The 'Bimatoowag Wabishke Maiingain', Running White Wolves, Youth Council are 12 Youth representing the eight Southeast First Nations in Manitoba including Poplar River, Berens River, Bloodvein, Brokenhead Ojibway Nation, Little Grand Rapids, Pauingassi, Black River and Hollow Water.

This fundraiser supports these opportunities to build strong leadership skills and cultural identities for our young people. The Youth Council advocate and advise on matters that impact the experiences of children and youth. They are leaders who amplify the voices of our young people. Through building positive relationships and supporting access to opportunities, the Youth Council build on their skills and confidence to take charge of their futures and show up in the world.

Last year's fundraising golf tournament raised \$47,410 that directly supported events and activities that engaged our young First Nations citizens in achieving their goals.

Here are some of the events this funding allowed our Youth Council to be a part of:

- Sweetgrass Planning Sessions
- Seasonal Leadership Gatherings
- Community Events at the Southeast First Nations
- #CanadaWeWant Conference National Students Commission of Canada
- End Homelessness Duty to Assist Conference

In the summer months, Youth Council members help staff and local resources facilitate programs and events such as Youth Summer Day Camps, Family Camps, and Treaty Days activities. Our Leadership Gatherings were hosted on the land, including Little Grand Rapids First Nation, Camp Manitou, Grey Buffalo Grandfather Wellness Lodge, and Clear Lake. These gatherings facilitate community building through creating opportunities for our young leaders to build and nurture relationships and networks where they will support one another throughout their lives. Through instilling confidence and sharing lessons that show that they have agency over their lives, our youth council are being prepared to become our next generation of strong First Nations leaders.
